





1. Canna F1 South Pacific Series



The indiaca is a ball game inspired from volleyball that is played alone or with a group using hands and feet. 
DIANTHUS



PENSTEMON

Penstemon Pentastic from **Hishtil** has a compact growth habit and beautiful extra-large pink, rose, red and (new) blush flowers of high density. This variety's self-branching in the short flower spikes strongly increases the blossom power and the color impact during a very long period.

PHLOX

Phloxstar, an annual phlox from **Danziger**, is a true rock star. Its tidy, compact habit makes it perfect in the landscape, in containers or hanging baskets. Annual phlox are typically impossible to root. Phloxstar roots very well, doesn't cycle out of flower and stands up to heat and drought. Spectacular new colors for 2019 include Red, White and Salmon.

REHMANNIA
Also known as Chinese



Foxglove, Rehmannia has always attracted interest in the past with its elegant flower spikes, large golden-throated flowers and all-summer flowering habit. However, most Rehmannia on the market tend to get rather floppy and untidy over time. Not so with '**Crouching Tiger**' from **Cultivaris**.

With a compact, flat rosette of glossy, dark-green, corrugated leaves and short, stout flower spikes that require absolutely no PGR treatment or staking, this is the first Rehmannia that has the potential to become a mainstream crop for spring/summer sales. The flowers are pure white with deep yellow throats tigereed with deep burgundy. Zones 7 to 9 hardy; requires a chill period for flower initiation, but then flowering nonstop all season.

RUDBECKIA HIRTA

Rising Sun Chestnut Gold is another first for **Green Fuse Botanicals**. This daylength neutral hirta brings ease to spring production on a traditionally long day plant. Huge flowers present nicely from spring through frost. The strong basal branching of Chestnut Gold produces twenty to thirty flowers on a single plant. This *Rubeckia hirta* may be grown to schedule and not to daylength. Zone 7. 18 to 20 inches.

SALVIA

The Cathedrals are well known among growers as a completely uniform series in both habit and bloom initiation. **Blue BiColor** from **Green Fuse Botanicals** follows suit

but offers a crisp blue/white contrasting flower. The Cathedrals' daylength neutrality makes for year-round scheduling ease.

Big Blue salvia from **PanAmerican Seed** is a vigorous flowering annual in a sales-inspiring clear blue color. The first of its type from seed, this big beauty will pump up mid-summer sales in large containers. Super easy and super showy for both landscapers and home gardeners for their back-of-border plantings, sending out blue spires continuously from July to first frost with little to no extra care. Big Blue is a great performer in heat and low-water conditions. Hummingbirds, bees, butterflies and more

flock to Big Blue in the garden. Height: 24 to 36 inches. Spread: 18 to 20 inches. Exposure: at its best in full sun, but will tolerate dappled shade or partial sun.

VERBENA

Ball FloraPlant is reinventing the verbena class. New **Cadet Upright** flowers one week earlier than other upright verbena on the market and has the most uniform habit across the series. The plants feature the same heat performance as EndurAscape but in a compact patio pot habit. All colors can be treated the same culturally during production. Cadet Upright has proven superior powdery mildew resistance when compared to the competition. Ideal for quart and high-density, pot-tight production — they won't tangle on the bench. Available in 7 colors for 2018. Height: 8 to 10 inches. Spread: 12 to 14 inches. Exposure: Sun.

The **Vanessa** verbena series from **Danziger** is bred for mildew tolerance and flower power. Danziger tests prospective varieties by inoculating the seedlings with mildew. Only those that stay clean and in full color are brought to market. Both single colors and bi-colors are early flowering. Cascading varieties are wonderful for hanging baskets, uprights are perfect for combo containers. Joining the series in 2019 are Bicolor Purple, Bicolor Pink, Violet and White.



VINCA

The art of plants comes alive on every **Vinca Tattoo** bloom. Each petal of this **PanAmerican Seed** variety looks “inked” with soft brush strokes of black, helping them stand out in stores and in the garden. Tattoo is very floriferous and well-branched with one-of-a-kind flowers in an overlapping form that won’t show gaps in hot temperatures. It has a three to five-day flowering window with an appealing upright habit across all four colors. Height: 10 to 14 inches. Spread: 6 to 8 inches. Exposure: sun.



VIOLA

A beautiful new color in the **Hem Genetics** Corina series of Viola, **Deep Blue and White** displays two deep blue-violet flag petals and three white lower petals splashed with purple and

displays a small central ‘face.’ This variety has a uniform plant habit with a height of 6 to 8 inches and a spread of 10 to 12 inches in the garden. This is consistent with the rest of the series of 22 separate colors. Plants will cover themselves in flowers, and because of their frost and freeze tolerance, they are the best choice for early and late season sales.

Terracotta Improved, another unique color in the **Hem Genetics** Corina series of Viola, provides shades of orange-bronze-rust for landscape beds, garden accents and container gardens. The original was introduced two years ago, but we found that in some cooler areas that it exhibited some purple shades as well, so the new one was selected for a cleaner

terracotta color. Like the rest of the Corina series, Terracotta has a uniform habit with a garden height of 6 to 8 inches and a spread of 10 to 12 inches.

Probably one of the most photographed new introductions at **Hem Genetics**’ California Spring Trials exhibit this year, Corina **White Rose Wing** is a unique attractive combination of two white-whiskered petals and two dusty rose flag petals, and a bottom petal whiskered and splashed with yellow. Like all of the Corinas, the plants have a uniform habit as an individual variety, as well as between other varieties in the series, to a height of 6 to 8 inches and spread of 10 to 12 inches in the garden. And they cover themselves with blooms throughout the growing season.
